Last Sunday we celebrated “Father’s Day”. The quote above came from Jane Addams, the eminent Chicago social worker and reformer who was presented with the idea for Father’s Day. But it was 1911 and the idea – at least in Chicago – went no where. But way to the west, a year earlier, in Spokane, Washington, Sonora Smart Dodd persuaded her minister and local civic officials to sponsor a “Father’s Day”. Thus she is credited with the idea of Father’s Day.

The idea, though, spread slowly across the country and it wasn't till the 1970s when Congress ultimately recognized our annual celebration of Father’s Day on the third Sunday in June. While probably not on par with Mother’s Day (which sees the most telephone calls of the year), nevertheless over the decades we have honored fathers on the third Sunday in June as those humans who contribute to the emergence of life on our earth. “Biology”, however, is only the beginning of fatherhood. A real father protects and cares of his children. A real father is there whenever he is needed. A real father sacrifices for the welfare of his children. There may be an ample supply of fathers who fail this test, but many more real fathers meet it. Father’s Day may not rank as a Hallmark moment, but a father who faithfully fulfills his duties won't have to worry about being left out in the cold. There will always be a warm spot for him in the hearts of his children.

We hope that all fathers, grandfathers, stepfathers and godfathers had a good day last Sunday! Thank you for all you do for your children!! Father Jude, osc~Team
